With more than 28 years of experience in Aboriginal organisations, cultural governance, and community leadership, Corrina is a passionate Cultural Educator devoted to Truth Telling and connection to Country. She leads Cultural Ceremonies, Walking Country experiences, and provides cultural input into place design, including the Geelong Arts Centre and the *Nyaal Banyul* – Geelong Convention Centre.

Founder of *Mok-borreeyn bagoork* ("Proud Woman"), Corrina is dedicated to revitalising Wadawurrung culture, language, and identity, continuing to inspire and advocate for truth, healing, and self-determination.
