Profile: David Karoly

David Karoly is a Chief Research Scientist in the CSIRO Climate Science Centre and an honorary Professor at the University of Melbourne. He is an internationally recognised expert on climate change.

David has been a Lead scientist in the National Environmental Science Program, a member of the National Climate Science Advisory Committee a member of the Climate Change Authority and the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change.

David is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Science and was awarded the Royal Society of Victoria Medal for Scientific Excellence in Earth Sciences. He was Professor of Atmospheric Science at the University of Melbourne and in the A.R.C. Centre of Excellence for Climate System Science (2007-18)

David's main presentation at Sacrededge is on the science, the impacts and the glimmers of hope on climate change. He will share the scientific community's conversations with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders in a separate session, and participate in a Climate Change panel.
