Profile: Pádraig Ó Tuama

Padraig is a theologian, writer, and conflict transformation practitioner. He is a member and former leader of the Corrymeela Community of Northern Ireland. His books include an incandescent memoir, **In the Shelter: Finding a Home in the World**; a prayer book, **Daily Prayer with the Corrymeela Community**; a book of poetry, **Sorry For Your Troubles**; and a book of theology and politics co-authored with Glenn Jordan, **Borders & Belonging**.

He hosts the On Being Studios podcast **Poetry Unbound**.

His new book, **Poetry Unbound: 50 Poems to Open Your World**, has just been published and is available wherever you get your books. Pádraig grew up in the Republic of Ireland, near Cork, but his vocation has taken him to the USA, Africa, and Australia.

Pádraig is married to Paul, and in 2011, they founded Tenx9, a storytelling event where nine people have up to ten minutes each to tell a true story from their lives.

Begun in Belfast, this event now has satellite events in many other cities, including Melbourne. He has brought his wit, intelligence and compassion to Sacrededge on two previous occasions, and Sacrededge is delighted to welcome him back.
