Profile: Tamil Welcome Feast

Nithiya, Moorthy, Nithi and Kumar are locally-based Refugees from Sri Lanka. After years of uncertainty, a relieved Nithi and Kumar achieved Permanent Residency Status in 2022, along with 19,000 others. However, Nithiya and Moorthy are amongst 12,000 refugees who continue to be denied permanent residency.

Together the four have established a Social Enterprise that offers a delicious monthly Tamil Community Meal at Unitingqueenscliff, sharing hospitality, gratitude, culture and traditional Tamil food.

They will cook the main course for us our Saturday Evening Dinner, which is included in the weekend registration.
