Gregory comes from a lineage of farmers and ecologists in his family in tropical lands in Brazil and he works in the intersection between plants and humans as **creative conduit for ecological thinking** and practices **with movement, performance and gardening**. His artistic and farming practices spans across vast range of fields, from ballet companies and contemporary dance, to TV & film; from Rio de Janeiro Carnival Parade to edible garden designs and community food programs; from queerComposting to zero waste growing and cooking. His plant & interspecies performance interactions take him all around the globe. He is currently the **director of Interdisciplinary Practice** at **The Victorian College of The Arts** (Melbourne University) the PLANT NATION Project: choreographic score devised by plants.
