Traditional and Contemporary, Neon Ngargee entertains and informs. We tailor themes for your Event: Seasons Dances, Bird Dances, Animal Dances, Life under the Water in Neon.

A collaborative dance, **Murrundaya Yepengna Dancers** invite singers, dance groups and musicians from the Kulin Nations to **join us, Neon up and share dances and songs with everyone.** The Neon Ngargee is an interactive immersion in art and Kulin Nation songs and dances.

We encourage the audience to get up and dance and sing and strong connections are formed. A live installation, a cultural interaction piece, And journey of spirit, The Neon Ngargee echoes the historical resonance of each story into our own present.
