STACEY WILSON was born on Gorokan tribal land in PNG in the year before independence, grew up on Yorta Yorta country and has raised her family in Wurundjeri land. Stacey is a qualitative research consultant with The Recollective. Her role also includes resource development, training and mentoring, specialising in the fields of intergenerational faith spaces and trauma informed child safety.

TALITHA FRASER is a Ngāi Tahu/Pākeha settler on the lands of the peoples of the Kulin Nation. Talitha is the Curator of The Recollective – a melting pot of contemplation, culture, and feminist theologies. Her creative practice is one of listening for what lies beneath context, story and place. How can ancient wisdom, poetics and mythology open our eyes to our responsibilities, privilege, inspiration, and the deep presentness of place.

Stacey and Talitha's workshop asks us Who directs the narrative of our story? and How may we understand stories as medicine - for others' and our own?' Byusing of silence, creativity, storytelling and curiosity they show how to develop resiliency towards healing for personal and collective trauma experiences.
