Considered one of Australia's most revered voices, Radical Son is the creative moniker of David Leha. A highly skilled artist, renowned for his magnetic performances, spell binding vocals and a style that fuses the sleek urgency of hip hop, and the emotional punch of soul, Radical Son is from the Kamilaroi nation of Australia and the South Pacific nation of Tonga.

Drawing power from his cultural roots and resolve from his challenging past, Radical Son elevates life's struggles and a lifelong pursuit of learning through his creative output from his debut 2014 full length album Cause N'Affect through to his 2024 ARIA Award nominated album, Bilambiyal (The Learning).

He has enjoyed standing ovations on stages across the country including Bluesfest, WOMADelaide and VIVID, and performed a show stopping cover of his mentor, the late Archie Roach's Walking into Doors.
